'Round 2 of Oilfield Auction in FY18'

New Delhi: The government will launch the second round of small oilfield auction in 2017-18, and introduce a policy to incentivise production from ageing fields in a bid to raise oil and gas output declining for the past few years, the oil minister has said.

The government will also come out with a policy to incentivise production from ageing fields, Pradhan said. "More domestic production is heavily dependent on Enhanced Oil Recovery(EOR)," he said. Many Indian fields, especially that of ONGC, are saddled with depleting reserves and require EOR techniques to raise recovery of oil and gas.

The government had earlier said it would begin the process of auction of major fields from July this year. All these steps are being taken to raise oil output that has fallen about 3% this fiscal year so far. Pradhan said there was no substitute for domestic oil output and state firms must do more to achieve that. PM Narendra Modi has set a road map for the industry to cut import dependence to 67% by 2022 from 82% now.
